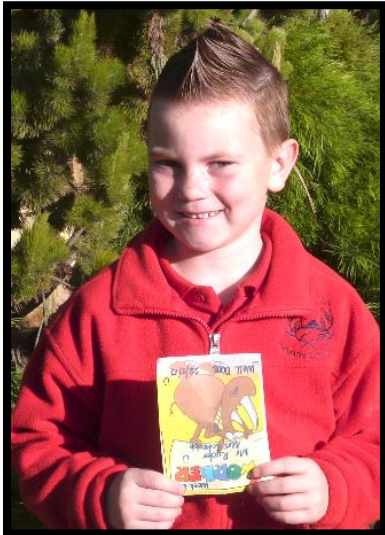

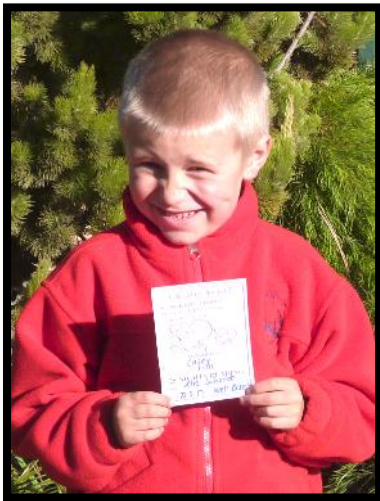

ABC-123 Soup



Do you want something to warm you up on those cold nights? Why not try the ABC-123 soup. You could also make eating tea a bit fun by playing a game such as finding a number or making a short word.

☺ You can also add other ingredients if you wish ☺ Happy cooking!

Serves 10 – Serve with wholemeal bread rolls

Ingredients:

- 20ml Olive oil
- 1 x Medium onion
- 650g Butternut pumpkin – Peeled and diced
- 2 x Large carrots – diced
- 2 x Large potatoes – diced
- 1 x Leek – washed and thinly sliced
- 750ml Vegetable stock
- 750ml Water
- 1x 400g can Brown lentils – Drained and rinsed
- 1cup of uncooked number or alphabet pasta

Method:

1. Heat oil in a large saucepan.
2. Add onion, pumpkin, carrots, potatoes and leek. Cook over a medium to high heat for 3 to 4 minutes.
3. Pour in stock, water, lentils and pasta
4. Bring to the boil and then reduce the heat and simmer, covered, for 30 minutes.
5. Serve the soup with a bread roll or a slice of crusty wholemeal bread.
